



Why Take a Driver Safety Course?

Because driving has changed since you first got your license, and doing so could save you money!

Seniors' Resource Center is now offering the AARP Driver Safety Program right here at our Southwest Plaza location.

- The course will be available in a classroom setting.
- After 6 or more people are signed up, a class will be scheduled with a 2-4 week advance notice.
- You may be eligible to receive an insurance discount upon completing the course, so consult your agent for details.
- Classes are arranged through a collaborative with the Denver Regional Mobility and Access Council (DRMAC) and AARP.
- You may be eligible to receive a discount on roadside assistance plans.
- The AARP Driver Safety Program has helped millions of drivers stay safe on the roads since its inception in 1979.
- Although it is geared to drivers age 50 and older, the course is open to people of all ages.
- AARP membership is not required to take the course.
- There is no test to pass.

The classroom course cost is only **\$12 for AARP members** and **\$14 for non-members**.*

You'll receive a certificate of completion after attending the course. Presenting this to your insurance agent can often result in a reduction in your premiums.

Participating states offer price reductions or discounts on auto insurance to motorists who complete the AARP Driver Safety Program, whether in the classroom or by taking the online course.

In many states, the discounts are mandatory. Legislation in 36 states, including Colorado, and the District of Columbia requires all automobile insurance companies conducting business in those states to offer insurance discounts to people completing a state-approved driver-improvement course in the classroom.

The class will take approximately 2 hours. Please call us at 303-979-6173 with any questions or to register.
